WEEKLY DRAWS: MONDAY MORNINGS, MAY 4 through OCTOBER 5

OPENING DAY for 2026 is May 4 and weekly draws will continue every Monday through October 5

There are **three exceptions**. When Monday is a statutory holiday the draw for that week will move to the next day, That's Tuesday! **Tuesday, May 19...Tuesday, August 4...Tuesday, September 1**

DEADLINE for weekly sign up is 6 PM TUESDAY evening each week. The DRAW will be finalized and posted by Wednesday evening. All members wishing to golf each week will need to sign up by entering your name in the google sheet provided through a link in the weekly email. Please fill the earlier tee times first to avoid large gaps in the draw.

Tee times begin at 9am in May & Sept and 8am in June, July and August. **ALWAYS KEEP YOUR TEE TIME AS ASSIGNED (DO NOT SWITCH GROUPS)** Please arrive 30 minutes before your tee time to check in and pay your fees. Golfers will be instructed to go to the first tee at their scheduled tee time. If your plans change once the draw is distributed it is your responsibility to notify the Pro Shop (306-777-7739).

FUN EVENTS ADDED TO WEEKLY DRAWS

- **ELEVEN FUN** events are included in the Regular Weekly League Play.
- An explanation of each Fun Draw will be included with the Weekly Draw.
- **To enter the Fun Draw place your Signed, Dated and Attested Scorecard in the Scorecard Drawer in Locker #13.**
- Winners will be announced via email and prizes awarded.

COMPETITIONS: INTERNAL.....for ALL Murray Women's Golf Club members (Full and Associate)

ALL SCORES MUST BE ENTERED IN GOLF CANADA ON A DAILY BASIS!

- **RINGER BOARD: FULL season.** Ringer Board will be posted in the Locker Room. Record your **BEST** scores for each hole of the golf rounds you complete in **Murray Women's Golf Club Sanctioned Events** throughout the season, that means all the events on the Fixture Sheet (Regular Weekly Draws, Best Ball games, Match Play rounds, Club Championship, Eclectic, etc.) Scores will be totalled at the end of the season and **NET** prizes awarded. Competition runs until the third Monday in September.

- **BIRDIE, EAGLE, CHIP-IN: FULL season.** Posted in the Locker Room. Record every Birdie or Eagle or Chip-in you have in **Murray Women's Golf Club Sanctioned Events**, that means all events on the Fixture Sheet (Regular Weekly Draws, Best Ball games, Match Play rounds, Club Championship, Eclectic, etc.) Prizes will be awarded at the end of the season for the golfer with the most in each category. Competition runs until the third Monday in September.
- **HOLE IN ONE: FULL season.** Record a hole in one at any course played during the season in the Birdie, Eagle, Chip-In book in the locker room.
- **BEST BALL COMPETITION: FULL season.** Posted in the Locker Room. Choose a Best Ball partner for the year. Each time you play **an 18-hole round at the Murray Golf Course on the same day as your partner** record your **NET BEST BALL** score on the board. At the end of the season your **THREE BEST BALL scores** will be totaled and prizes awarded. Competition runs until the third Monday in September.
- **MATCH PLAY COMPETITION: June 1–SEPTEMBER 17. DEADLINE TO SIGNUP: Tuesday, May 20TH.** Sign up in the Locker Room or by email. Please **complete** your match in the time allotted. Questions about format?....ask Your Handicap Chair or Handicap Assistant..
- **CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP: AUGUST 10 and AUGUST 11.** Format: 36-hole individual stroke play. All Murray Women's Golf Club members (Full and Associate) are eligible to enter if they have played in a minimum of FIVE Club Sanctioned Events throughout the season. A Club Champion will be declared as well as numerous flight prizes. The top 4 players will be selected to represent the MWGC at the Golf SK Champions Cup tournament.
- **ECLECTIC TOURNAMENT: JULY 27 and AUGUST 4** Format: individual low gross score per 18-holes. Each competitor uses lowest score for each hole per individual stroke play from one or both of the rounds scheduled.
- **NATIONAL GOLF LEAGUE (NGL):** Format: Net Stableford points played on the front 9. Members who sign up agree to donate \$25.00 to Golf Canada's First Tee program, payable through mwgdeposits@gmail.com. Six dates designated plus one additional optional date. Minimum of four (4) 9-hole games required.

COMPETITIONS:

- **2026 PGA SK PRO LADY: JUNE 1. Moon Lake Golf & Country Club, Saskatoon.**
 - Format: Modified scramble for amateurs, Stroke play for the Pro, Best score between the two.
 - Murray will pay the entry fee for 3 members plus the Pro to participate.
 - **TWO Qualifiers will be held: MAY 11 and MAY 25. Candidates may play in one or both of the qualifiers and their best score will be used.**
- **2026 MURRAY-TOR HILL THE SWINGING SISTERS: JUNE 8. Murray Golf Course.**
 - All members of the Murray Women's Golf Club and the Tor Hill Ladies Golf Club are eligible to play.
 - Format: Two Lady - Blind Partner teams; 18-holes, Net Better Ball scores per hole.
 - Prizes will be awarded: skill (closest to the pin, etc.) and novelty (gift basket.)
- **2026 WOMEN'S ROSE BOWL: AUGUST 18 & 19. Greenbryre Golf & Country Club, Saskatoon.**
 - Format: 2-lady team; 36-hole, Net best ball using Stableford points per hole.
 - Murray will pay the entry fee for one 2-lady team to participate.

- **TWO Qualifiers will be held: JULY 13 and JULY 20. Candidates may play in one or both of the qualifiers and their best score will be used.**
- No single golfer's factor can be lower than 10.0 and combined team handicap factor must be between 20.0 and 72.4.
- Members who meet the handicap requirements can also enter a team in the tournament at their own expense directly through Golf SK.

REGINA LADIES INTERCLUB CHAMPIONSHIP: SEPTEMBER 14. Tor Hill.

- Format: 4-lady team, 18-holes net Stableford points per hole.
- Team will have 1 golfer from each of these handicap factor ranges: 0-16.9, 17.0-23.7, 23.8-28.9, 29.0-40.4
- Murray will pay the entry fee for one 4-lady team to attend. Golfers will be responsible for the green fees and cart fees.
- **TWO Qualifiers will be held: AUGUST 17 and AUGUST 24. Candidates may play in one or both of the qualifiers and their best score will be used.**
